### **Discipline**

### **Officer Team Offenses:**

- Not abiding by the FFA Code of Ethics at any time.
- Unexcused absences: Anything but an illness or family emergency.
- Failure to complete assigned task: Not upholding a responsibility given as an FFA officer.

### **Offenses resulting in immediate removal from Chapter Officer Team:**

- A third absence from a required chapter event.
- Use and/or possession of alcohol or drugs.
- Use and/or possession of tobacco.
- Stealing or possession of stolen goods.
- Use and/or possession of weapons.
- Defiance of advisor, administrator, or other teacher.
- Two consecutive grading periods below 2.5 GPA.
- Fighting.
